As host of *Your Move with Andy Stanley*, which delivers more than 10.5 million messages each month through television and podcasts and author of more than 20 books, including *Parenting: Getting It Right; Irresistible; Better Decisions, Fewer Regrets; The New Rules for Love, Sex & Dating; How to Be Rich; Deep & Wide; Enemies of the Heart; When Work & Family Collide; Visioneering; and Next Generation Leader*, he is considered one of the most influential pastors in America.

Nothing is as personal as his passion for engaging with live audiences, which he has pursued for more than two decades at leadership events around the world. “I cannot fill their cups,” he often says of the opportunity to impact leaders in business and in ministry, “but I have a responsibility to empty mine.”
